- Charities must be based in Sussex or within the immediate surrounding areas.

They must then be:

- Charities involved in the promotion of community participation in health recreation for those up to the age of 18 years old.

OR

- Charities involved in the relief of sickness and the preservation of health for those up to the age of 18 years old.

OR

- Charities promoting activities which develop the skills, capacities and capabilities of under 18's to enable them to participate fully in society as mature and responsible individuals.

GRANT APPLICATION PROCEDURE

To apply to Wellesley Charitable Foundation for a grant, a charity must complete the application form. The form is available via email request, by telephone or by letter.

All applications must be accompanied by a full copy of the charity's latest annual report and audited accounts.
